

TOWER HALL FUNABORI

a nick-name for 「SOGO KUMIN HALL」



Event Hall

Taiyo-no-ma

A hall having an area of about 1500m² and ceiling heights of 6~7m, dividable into 4 separate rooms by using double partition walls which ensure sound insulation, and suitable for after-wedding celebrations, large-scale receptions, symposiums, etc.

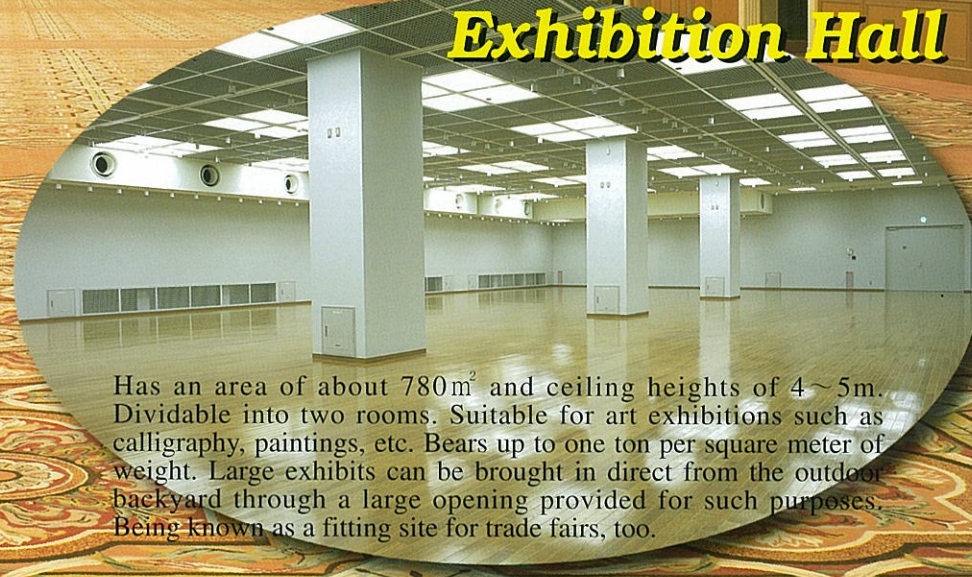


Japanese-style Room



A room having a fireplace and a washing place designed specifically for holding regular tea ceremonies. Can be used to entertain overseas visitors of Edogawa Ward or as a place for betrothal present exchanging ceremonies.

Exhibition Hall



Has an area of about 780m² and ceiling heights of 4~5m. Dividable into two rooms. Suitable for art exhibitions such as calligraphy, paintings, etc. Bears up to one ton per square meter of weight. Large exhibits can be brought in direct from the outdoor backyard through a large opening provided for such purposes. Being known as a fitting site for trade fairs, too.

Observation Tower



North The graceful figure of Katsushika Harp Bridge catches your eye and makes you realize that Edogawa is truly "a town of water and greenery".



You can see not only the whole city of Edogawa but also, in clear weather, Mt. Fuji and the mountains of Chichibu to the west, the new showplace of Tokyo Bay "Umi-hotaru" to the south, Mt. Tsukuba far away to the north-east and all the panoramas which a height of 103m from the ground level can offer. Each elevator that brings you up to and down from the observation rooms has a display showing its speed per minute and changing height from the ground level. It is also equipped with a vibration control system which minimizes the effects of wind, etc. In the event of an emergency such as an earthquake, the cameras set on the tower catch the exact situation of what's happening on the ground and report it to the control center to ensure that proper steps will be taken to meet the situation.



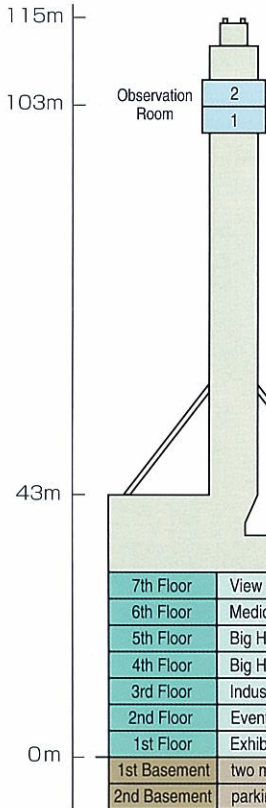
East Makuhari New City as well as ship traffic on Tokyo Bay (on the border between Tokyo and Chiba Prefecture) can be seen. This side offers as impressive view of the Edogawaku Fireworks Display, which is a summer tradition.



West Tokyo Tower is clearly visible. In clear weather, you can see the mountain mass of Tanzawa and Mt. Fuji.



South You see Tokyo Disneyland beyond the Edo River. Following downstream the river reflecting the setting sun, you come to Tokyo Bay.

1st Floor	Exhibition Hall, tenants, General Information
1st Basement	two movie theaters, tenants (musical instruments shop, cashpoint), parking area for 74 cars
2nd Basement	parking area for 87 cars
